NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK

WHEREAS, May 16 – 22, 2021 is celebrated as NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK; and

WHEREAS, National Public Works Week is a celebration of the men and women who provide and maintain the infrastructure and services collectively known as public works with the 2021 theme of “Stronger Together”; and

WHEREAS, by working together, the impact citizens and public works professionals can have on their communities is magnified and results in the ability to accomplish goals once thought unattainable; and

WHEREAS, Public Works helps maintain a community's strength by working together to provide an infrastructure of services in transportation, water, wastewater, and stormwater treatment, public buildings and spaces, parks, and grounds, emergency management and first response, solid waste, and right-of-way management; and

WHEREAS, Public Works provides togetherness needed for collaboration with all the stakeholders in capital projects, infrastructure solutions, and quality of life services; and

WHEREAS, the support and understanding of an informed citizenry is vital to the efficient operations of public works programs; and

WHEREAS, the health, safety and comfort of this community greatly depends on the efforts and skills of dedicated public works employees; and

WHEREAS, so long as the design, construction, operation, and maintenance of these facilities works smoothly the people behind the scene are often forgotten.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Juslyn C. Manalo, Mayor and members of the City Council of Daly City hereby proclaim May 16 – 22, 2021 as NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK, in the City of Daly City, and call upon all residents and civic organizations in the community to acquaint themselves with the issues involved in providing effective public works and to recognize the contributions which public works employees make every day to our health, comfort, and quality of life.
