


# Proclamation

## *National Public Works Week, May 15 -21, 2022*


- WHEREAS,** May 15 – 21, 2022 is celebrated as National Public Works Week; and
- WHEREAS,** National Public Works Week is a celebration of the dedicated public works professionals who provide and maintain the infrastructure and services collectively known as public works with the 2022 theme of “Ready and Resilient”; and
- WHEREAS,** Public Works professionals focus on infrastructure, facilities and services that are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health, high quality of life and well-being of the people of the City of Daly City; and
- WHEREAS,** these infrastructure, facilities and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, who are engineers, managers, and employees at all levels, who are responsible for rebuilding, improving, and protecting our nation’s transportation, water, wastewater and stormwater treatment, public buildings, parks, and other structures and facilities essential for our citizens; and
- WHEREAS,** it is in the public interest for the citizens, civic leaders and children in the City of Daly City to gain knowledge of and to maintain an ongoing interest and understanding of the importance of public works and public works programs in their respective communities; and
- WHEREAS,** the health, safety and comfort of this community greatly depends on the efforts and skills of dedicated public works employees; and
- WHEREAS,** so long as the design, construction, operation and maintenance of these facilities works smoothly the people behind the scene are often forgotten.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, DR. 




