







Q1x3 Are you, a resident of Daly City, CA?






Q1x5 What is your age as of your last birthday?









Q2x5 How would you rate your current community as a place for people to live as they age?




Q2x6 Thinking about your future years, are you more likely to move to a different community, move to a different residence within your current community or stay in your current residence and never move?











Q4x4 How important is it for you to be able to live independently in your own home as you age?









Q10x3 How likely is it that you will continue to work as long as possible, rather than choosing to retire and no longer work for pay?







Q16x2 How likely is it that you will provide unpaid care to an adult loved one in the future?





Q16x3 What is the highest level of education that you completed?






Q16x5 Which language do you prefer to speak?





Q16x6 What race do you consider yourself?





Q16x7 Thinking about your state elections for Governor and Legislators in the last 10 years, which of the following best describes your voting behavior? How often would you say you vote?




